Enhancements being made to ACCESS

The Department of Health Services will be hosting trainings in October for community partners regarding enhancements being made to ACCESS on October 24, 2015. ACCESS will be updated with new features that will expedite application processing for applicants. For some applicants, these new features will allow additional online data matching to minimize the need for additional verification and for a small number of applicants, it could mean they are able to get an immediate eligibility determination. This new, immediate eligibility determination is referred to as real-time eligibility. The MyACCESS tool is also being enhanced to allow existing members to apply for additional programs through a streamlined process – Add a Program.
