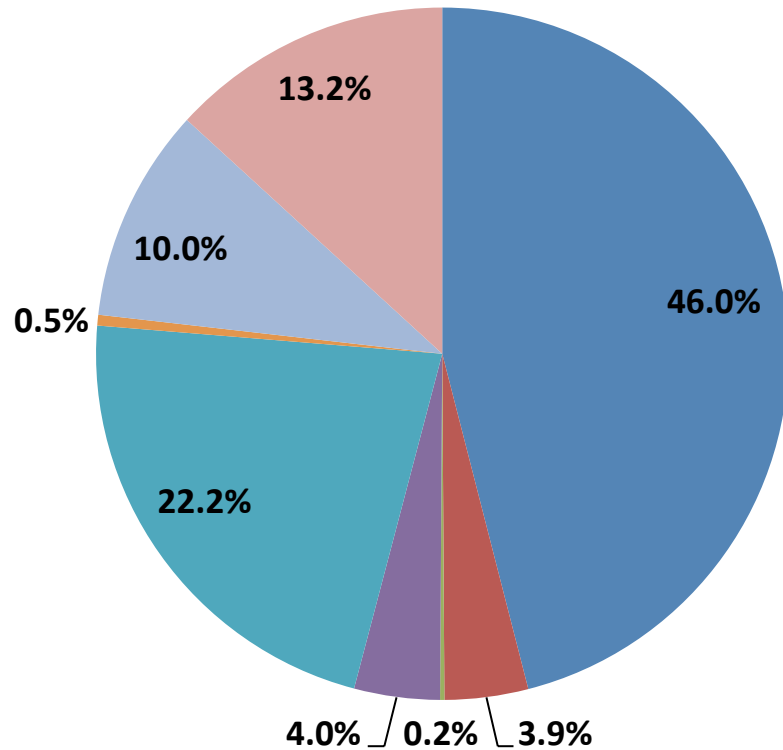

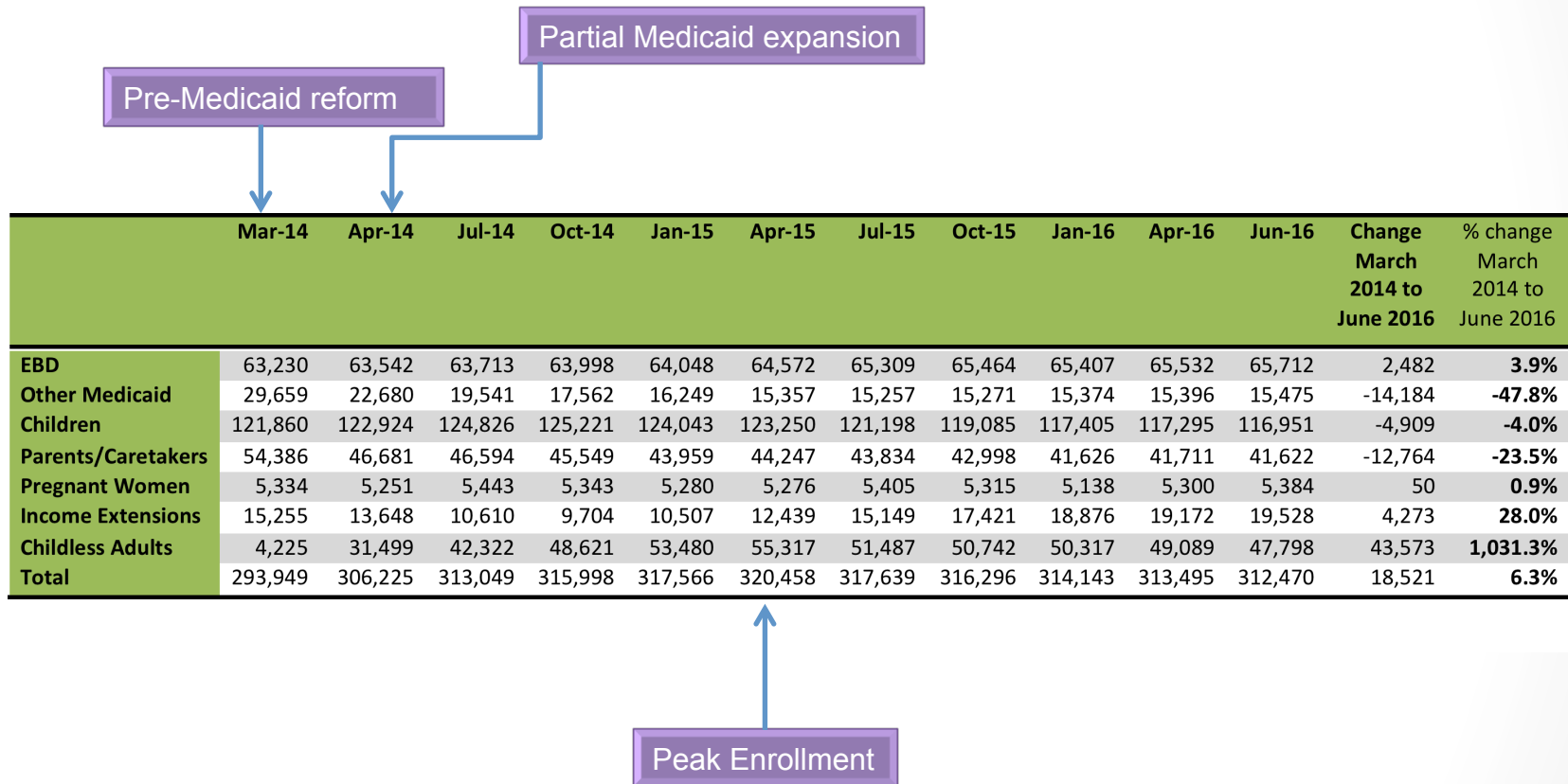

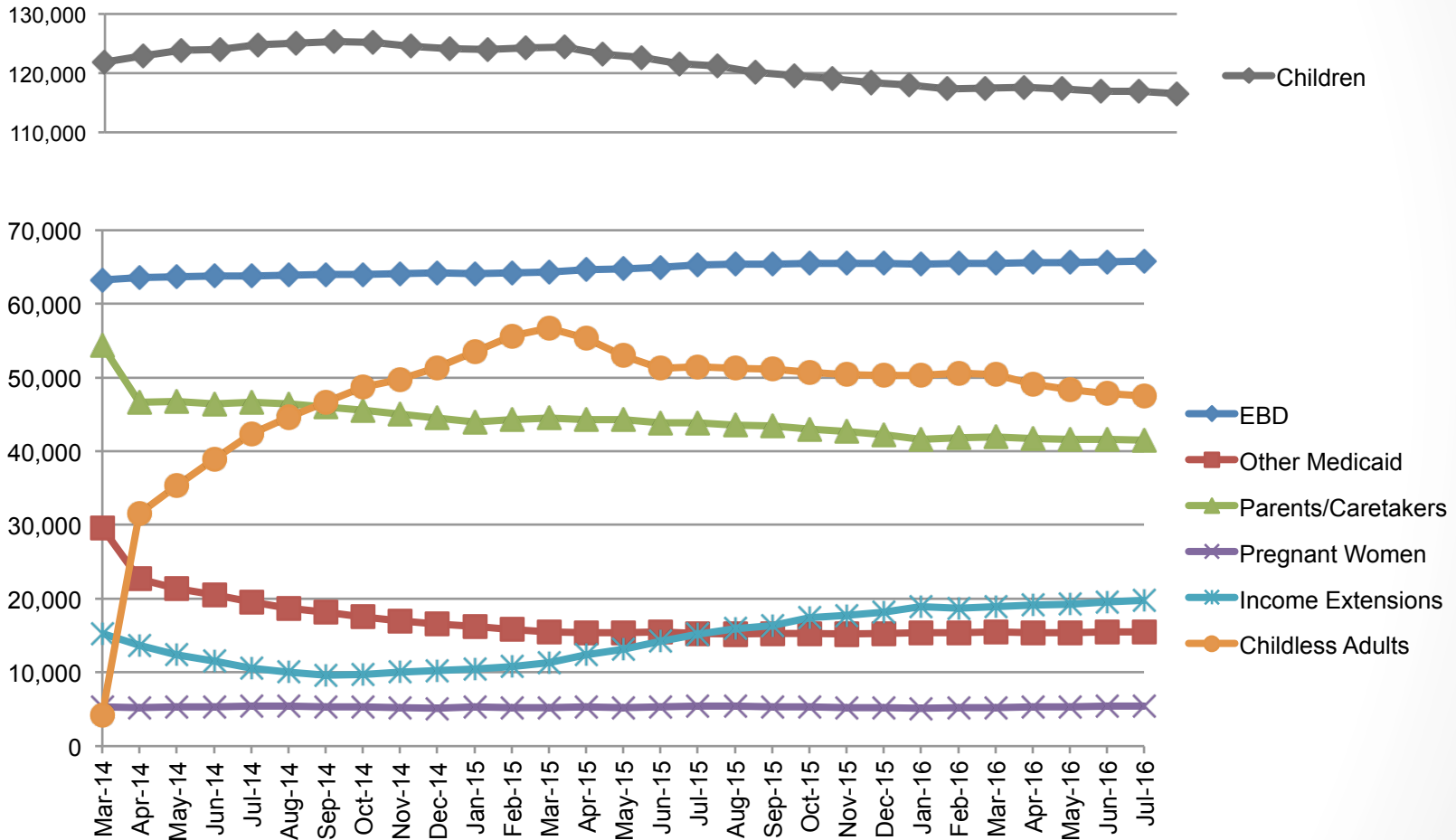
Medicaid / BadgerCare Trends

Milwaukee County, March 2014 to July 2016

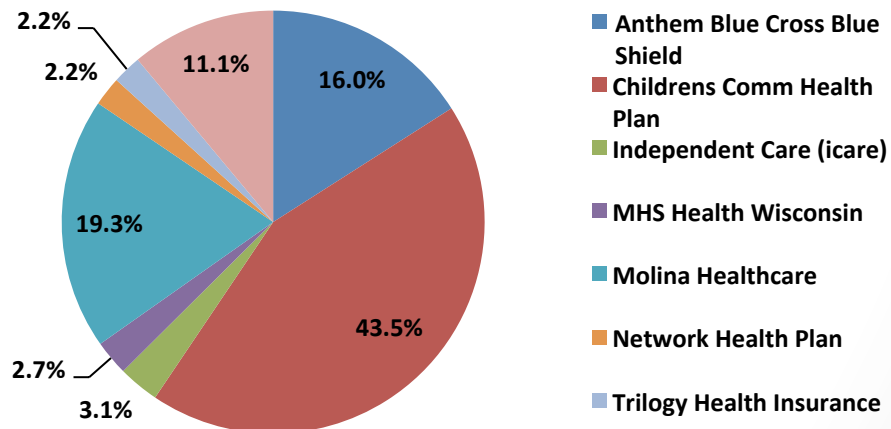

Distribution of BadgerCare Enrollment

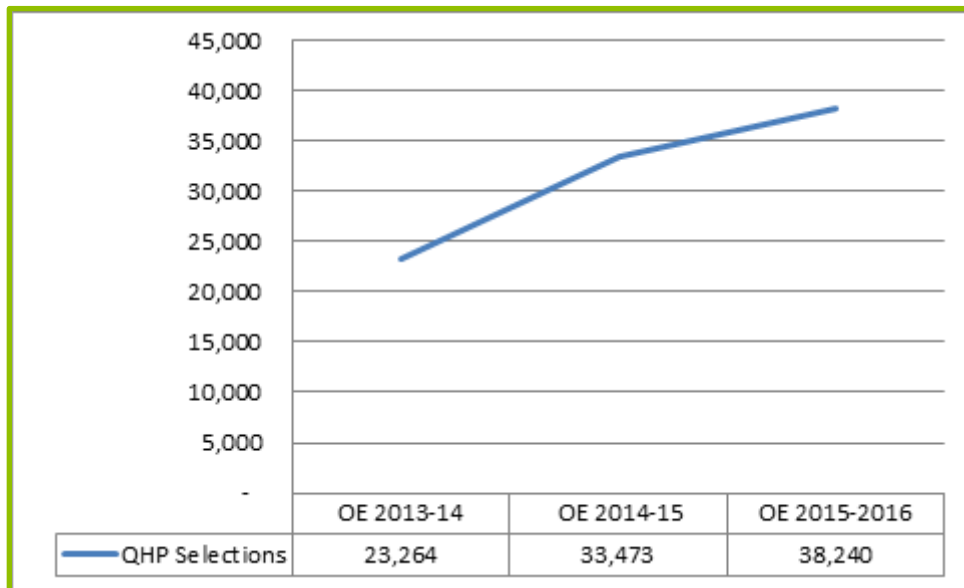

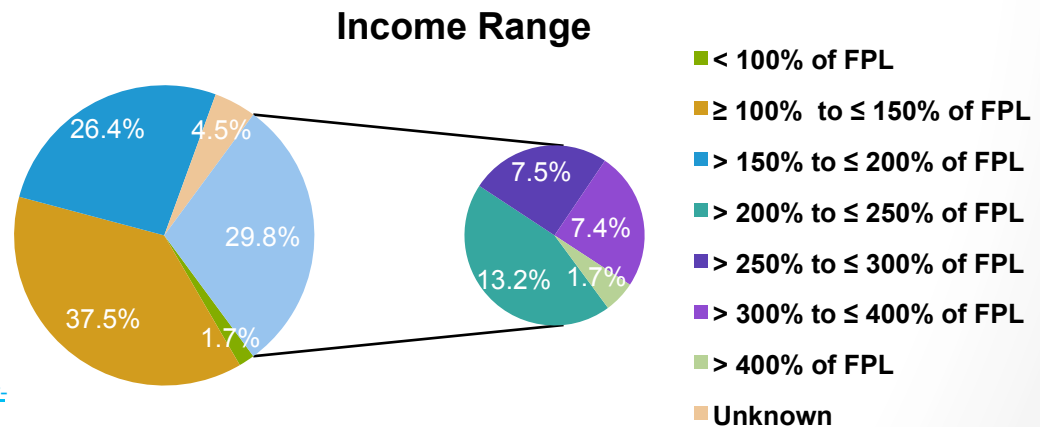

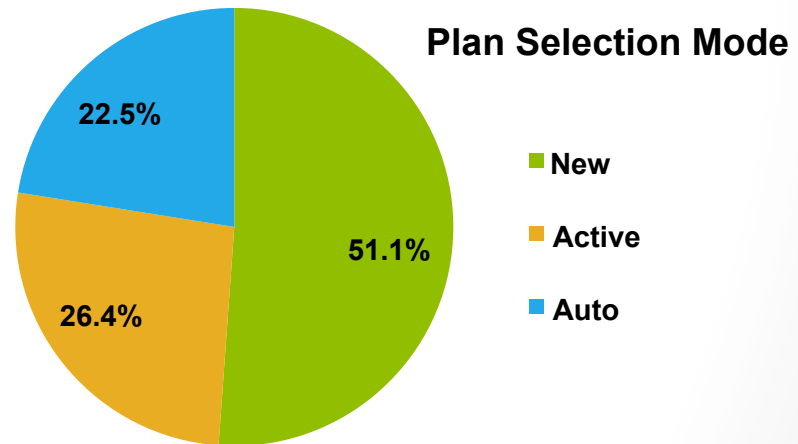
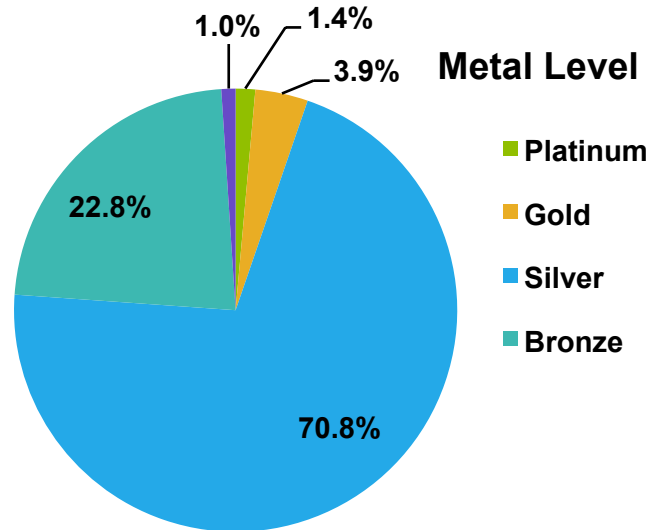

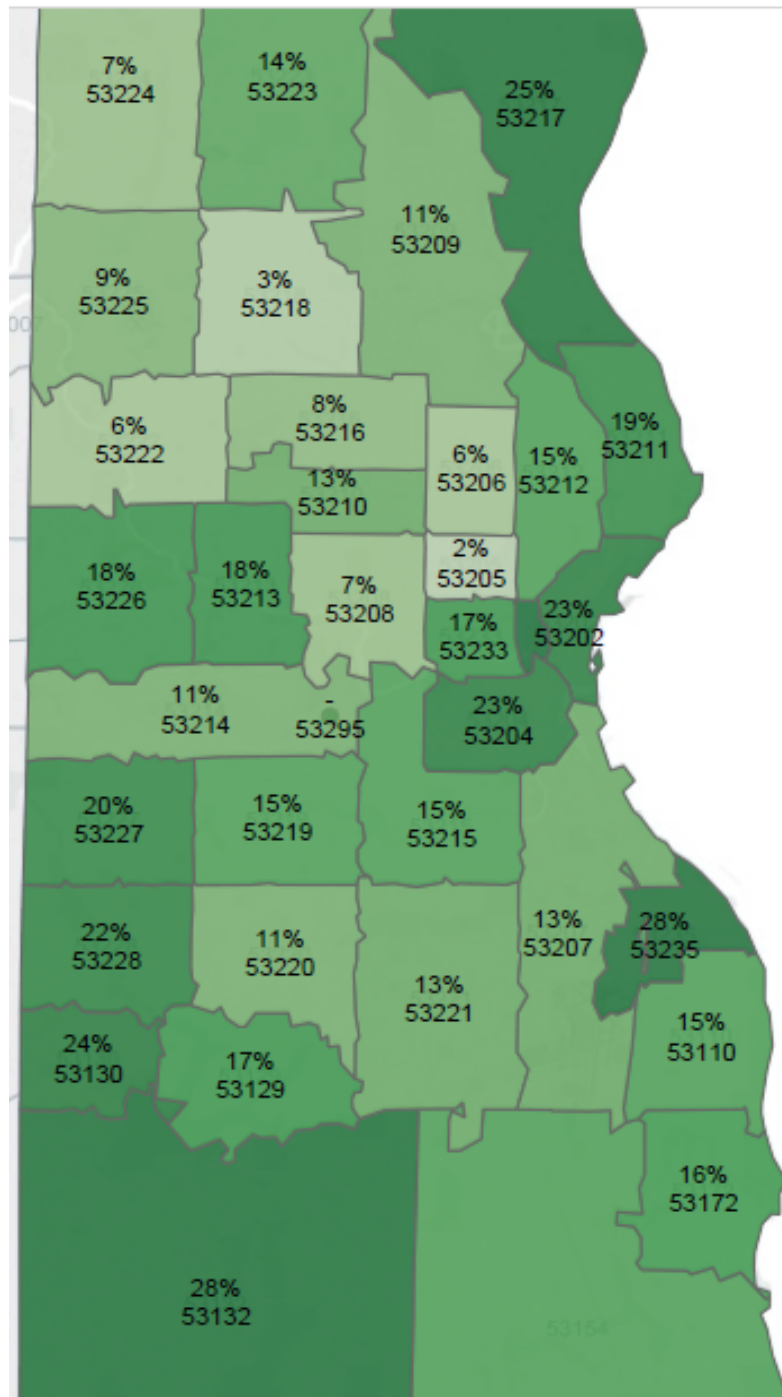

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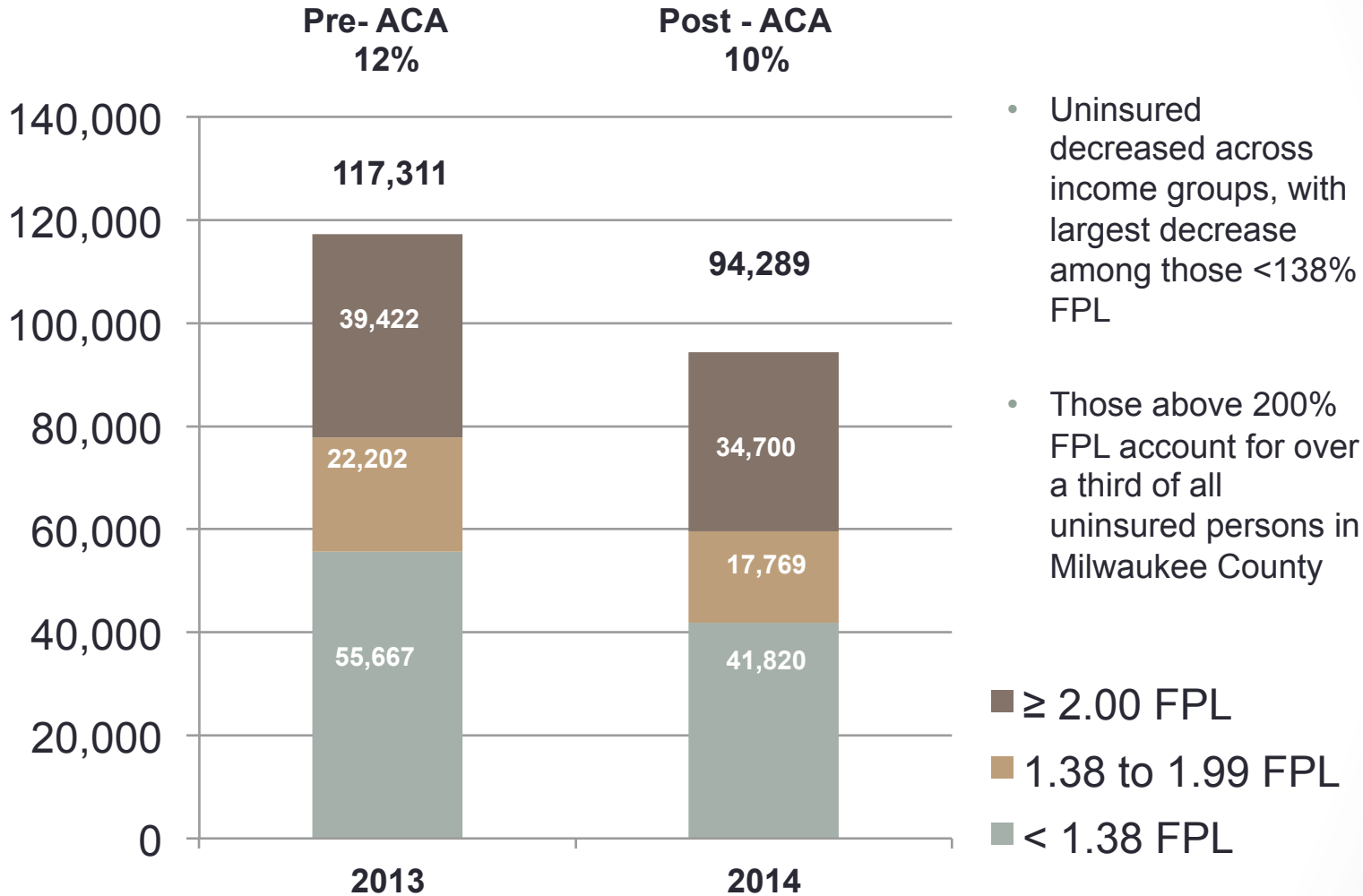
