BadgerCare Plus 101

Thursday, July 30, 8:45 am - 10:15 am Wheaton Franciscan - Wauwatosa Campus

ACCESS 101

Learn all the basic functions of ACCESS (the state's benefits enrollment website for BadgerCare+, Medicaid, Family Planning Services, FoodShare, and other related benefits). This training will also touch on how to use ACCESS to submit verification required by applicants, and access member notices. The training will be conducted by our partners from DHS. **Participants are encouraged to come 15 minutes early (8:45) and/or stay 15 minutes after (10:45) to practice using ACCESS on the state's training site.**
