# **FINANCIAL SUPPORT**

In addition to members' operational support, the Partnership leverages and aligns funding to advance its priorities of coverage, access, care coordination and community health through:

## **Shared Community Investment Fund (SCIF)**

Strategic investments with community partners, supported by annual health system contributions. The SCIF represents health systems' pooled resources in addition to their individual community benefit commitments.

## **Health Improvement Fund (HIF)**

A United Way of Greater Milwaukee and Waukesha County designated fund that supports organizations providing health care and enabling services for low-income, underserved populations in Milwaukee county, with the aim of improving health outcomes and reducing disparities.

## **Extramural Funding**

Grants secured by the Partnership from foundations and corporations that support its sponsored programs, such as medication assistance, health information exchange and enrollment outreach/education.
