# **Highlights - December 2018**

## MEDICAID ENROLLMENT

- About a third of Milwaukee County residents (32.6%), and half of all children (47.2%), are enrolled in a Medicaid program.
- BadgerCare Plus child enrollment decreased this quarter in Milwaukee County and statewide.
- As of December 2018, 48,788 childless adults are enrolled in BadgerCare Plus in Milwaukee County. The number of people enrolled is down 8,543 enrollees since its peak in March 2015.

## MARKETPLACE ENROLLMENT


 Wisconsin experienced a 9.0% decrease of enrollment in the ACA Marketplace during the six-week open enrollment period for calendar year 2019 plans compared to the open enrollment period for calendar year 2018 plans. (County level data should be available by March 2019.)

## MILWAUKEE UNINSURED RATE

- Based on most recently available data (year end 2017), 67,966 people, approximately 7.2% of the Milwaukee County population, are uninsured.
- Approximately 58% of Milwaukee County's uninsured residents (~39,057 individuals) are below 200% of the Federal Poverty level (FPL).
- Approximately 25% of Milwaukee County uninsured residents (16,952 individuals) have incomes below 100% FPL, some of whom may qualify for Medicaid benefits.
- An estimated 70% of uninsured people in Milwaukee County are employed.





## Milwaukee County, March 2014 to December 2018





## Milwaukee County, December 2008 to December 2018




- EBD includes SSI, SSI-related, Institutionalized, Waiver, MAPP, Katie Beckett Program.

- Gradual declines are occurring in Institutionalized and Waiver programs.














