Give to the Health Improvement Fund

In 2011, the Milwaukee Health Care Partnership (MHCP) and the United Way launched the **Health Improvement Fund (HIF)** to help connect vulnerable people with affordable **health care coverage** and the **medical, dental, and behavioral health care** services that meet their needs. HIF dollars also provide access to **navigation and other support services** that ensure positive health outcomes.

HIF contributions support organizations working towards one or more of the **shared MHCP and United Way priorities**:

- COVERAGE
- CARE COORDINATION
- ACCESS
- COMMUNITY HEALTH



The Health Improvement Fund is a United Way challenge grant supported by the health system members of MHCP (Advocate Aurora Health, Ascension Wisconsin, Children's Wisconsin and Froedtert Health).

Together, they have pledged \$2 million to match HIF contributions 6 to 1!

Your contribution to the HIF will:

- Strengthen families' connection to primary care "health homes"
- Connect people with serious health concerns to affordable specialty care
- Make sure people can get important medications, like insulin, despite their ability to pay
- Provide expanded access to dental care for children and adults
- Increase access to mental and behavioral health services in a variety of community settings
- Help low-income people navigate social services and the health care system in general, so they can get *the right care at the right time in the right place*
