
# Mental Health Access

## "HIGH ACUITY" DEFINITION

- Developed tiered definition to support systematic identification of youth with high acuity, complex needs across sectors
- Developed recommendations for a crosssector system response for identified youth in crisis
- Commissioned support for whitepaper to disseminate and implement system pilots

#### **ED PROTOCOL**

 An ER-focused care coordination protocol for youth in out-of-home care was implemented at Children's WI Emergency Department (Q1 2023) and MHEC (Q3 2023). In June, the protocol was updated to reflect Wraparound's transition away from HMO services.
